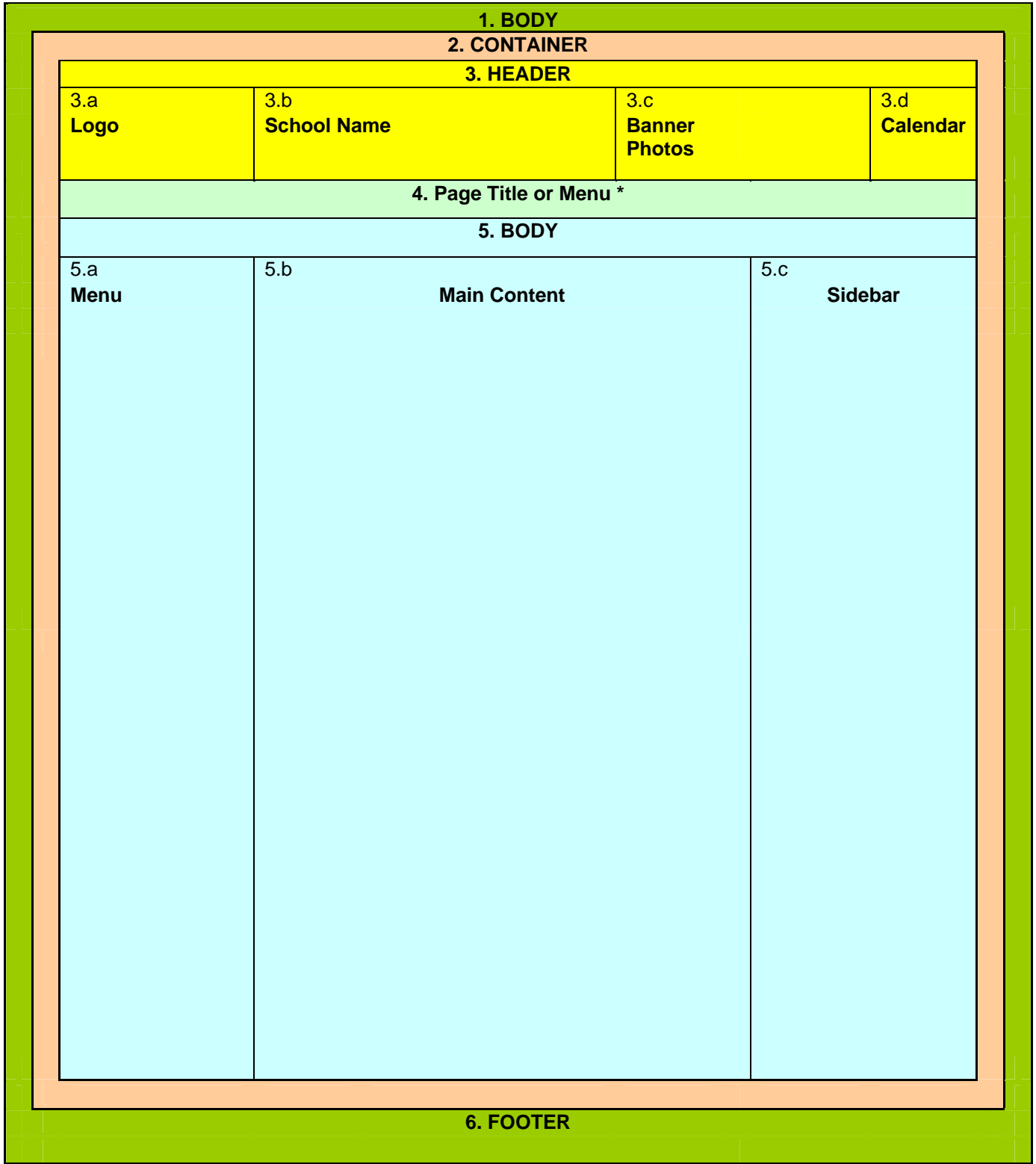


# Typical School Web Page Layout



This is the typical school web page layout.

The web page is divided into 6 main parts:

1. The BODY - this is the entire browser window displaying the page
2. The CONTAINER - this is the part of the page that contains all the information  
The BODY and CONTAINER can have different backgrounds, which is usually the case.
3. The HEADER - this displays the:
  - a. School logo
  - b. School Name - sometimes as a photo of the school that displays the name
  - c. Banner Photos in some cases
  - d. CalendarThese can be arranged in any order.
4. The Page Title - the placement is optional and is sometimes located in the HEADER section. This area could have a horizontal menu if required.
5. The BODY - this is the main area which will change as the user browses the web site. It is divided into 3 parts:
  - a. The Menu
  - b. The Main Content - this is where all of the content is displayed with the exception of slides and PDF files. The background of the Main Content can differ from the BODY and the CONTAINER; this is usually the case. The background is selected so that there is high contrast between the text and background. A solid colour or subtle colour gradient is best here.
  - c. The Sidebar - this has the latest news, Word of the Day, Flag counter, etc.  
These 3 parts can be arranged in any order, but this is the order that most viewers are familiar with.
6. The FOOTER - This contains the copyright and links to other schools and lies below the CONTAINER.
